

Cambuslang Golf Club - Local Rules

GENERAL.

If a staked tree interferes with a players stance or the area of their intended swing, the ball must be lifted and dropped without penalty, as prescribed in Rule 24-4b.

Area defined by white Lines:

Areas defined by white lines are deemed GUR and the ball may be lifted and dropped not nearer the hole without penalty.

Blue staked areas:

A ball coming to rest within an area that is defined by blue stakes can be dropped at the nearest point of relief without penalty.

Immovable obstructions:

Water points and manhole covers

Distance markers

Dannart wire and barbed wire

Paths and roadways:

A ball coming to rest on any paths or roadways should be lifted and dropped not nearer the hole without penalty.

STONES IN BUNKERS:

Stones interfering with play in bunkers may be removed without penalty.

OUT OF BOUNDS:

Out of bounds is determined by the perimeter fence except beyond 9th green where the following applies:

- a) On the extreme right hand side of the green between the bush and the perimeter fence, the line of sight is determined by the line of white marker posts.
- b) Immediately behind the 9th green, a ball coming to rest on the gravel ditch is deemed to be out of bounds.
- c) On the extreme left hand side of the 9th green, a ball beyond the line of the white marker post at the end of the ditch and the white marker post at the other side of the Gents tee is deemed to be out of bounds.

WATER HAZARD:

Lateral water hazards are clearly defined by red stakes.

Water hazards are clearly defined by yellow stakes.

INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE:

Integral parts of the course are:

- a) Ha-Ha Wall at the 4th hole.
- b) Railway sleepers and bridges.

Ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable as prescribed in Rule 28.

All Temporary Local Rules are defined on the Notice Boards.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF A LOCAL RULE:

Match play – Loss of Hole.

Stroke Play – Two Stroke Penalty.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES:

Devices capable of measuring distance ONLY are permitted strictly in accordance with Rule 14-3.
